The Stanislavski Approach: An Actor Prepares

This course demystifies the welter of contradictory interpretation about the Father of Modern Acting. You will investigate the tools and techniques developed by Stanislavski and how they are now utilized by modern actors in the 21st century. You will apply the approach to selected scenes – this is a practical course, not a theoretical one!

Working With Text: An Actor's Toolkit

Where and how do you begin when presented with your new script? We will explore, play and work in detail on selected scenes. Students will additionally develop skills in sight-reading, rehearsal technique, characterisation and stagecraft.

Shakespeare: An Actor's Approach

Shakespeare wrote his plays to be performed and filled his text with clues which are accessible to any actor who is prepared to play. This course explores the wonderful world of iambic pentameter and how rhythm, sound and imagery can release and support the actor.

Each course runs from 10am – 5pm with a performance at 7pm on the final Friday. Fees are £150 per week. Concessions and discounts available – please enquire.
